Court Supports Our Voting Rights

This Independence Day holiday we have more reason to celebrate than ever – we are closer than ever to a vote for representation at Delta Air Lines.

The U.S. District Court in Washington, D.C., has ruled in favor of new, more democratic rules for voting under a National Mediation Board (NMB) representation election, denying a request by Delta and its industry lobby, the Air Transport Association (ATA), to delay the rules.

Delta has stated it will not appeal the decision, and we urge our company to live up to its word and allow the vote to proceed under the new rules.

We're Filing for the Vote

With the new rules going into effect, Delta AFA is filing for single-carrier status for the purposes of flight attendant representation, and our long wait for a chance to vote soon will be over. Under the new rules, only those who vote can decide the outcome, and the NMB will stop assigning "no" votes to those who do not participate.

Finally our voice will be heard and fully respected under strong democratic procedures, the same way that other elections are decided in our country. It's an American right, and an American privilege!
